Eligibility Criteria



In order to become a part of EBRD Green Cities, cities must meet the following criteria:

- **Located in EBRD's Countries of Operation**
- Population ≥ 100,000 (≥ 50,000 in relevant circumstances)
- **Conduct a Green City Action Plan** 3
- **Initiate 'Trigger' Infrastructure Project**


In one of the following sectors:

- Projects must target a 20% reduction in GHG emissions, energy or resource consumption, or pollution; or have significant climate resilience benefits


