

EU-Ukraine Municipal Partnership Forum in Wojnowice (Wroclaw)

January 25-27, 2023

Location of forum: Zamek na wodzie (Zamek Wojnowice), Zamkowa 2, 55-330 Wojnowice, Poland, 8 km from Wroclaw

Short description of the event

With the beginning of the full-scale Russian invasion of Ukraine, Ukrainian communities received a lot of attention from their partners from EU countries, who provided assistance to their Ukrainian colleagues. Such cooperation worked fastest where long-standing ties already existed. Therefore, many communities in Ukraine, including newly created within the framework of the decentralization reform in Ukraine, realized the need to create their own networks of partnerships. In turn, there was a demand among communities in EU countries to find partners for long-term relationships in Ukraine.

The Municipal partnership forum in Wojnowice (Wroclaw) aims at development of partnerships between Ukrainian and EU municipalities. The event will gather around 60 participants who declare their interest in developing a long-term cooperation.

The forum is organized by **Cities4cities | United4Ukraine initiative**, with the financial support of the USAID.

Cities4cities | United4Ukraine is initiative co-organized by SALAR International, Lviv (Ukraine) and Sindelfingen (Germany). The strategic partners of the initiative are The Congress of Local and Regional Authorities of the Council of Europe, Association of the Ukrainian Cities, All-Ukrainian Association of the Amalgamated Communities.
