The Executive Director of UN-Habitat, Maimunah Mohd Sharif, announced the establishment of the **Shanghai Award** at the first session of the 2022 UN-Habitat Executive Board on 30 March 2022. The award is jointly established by UN-Habitat and the Shanghai Municipality. The theme of the first cycle of Shanghai Award is "Building Sustainable Urban Future for All." Cities worldwide that have made significant progress in economic vitality and urban prosperity, green urban development, urban safety and resilience, and capacity building for sustainable urban development are encouraged to apply. The application process envisages self-application and application with a nomination. The submission of entries will close on 30 June 2023.
